

The Pinnacle of Cosmic Design and Purpose: The Cosmic 'Axis of Evil', The Cosmic Axis of God and The Greatest of all Axis

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ABSTRACT

1. The Cosmic Microwave Background Radiation

By the interpretation of big bang cosmology, the cosmic microwave background radiation is leftover heat generated by the big bang some 13 billion years ago. Think of it as an explosion of a bomb which generates extreme heat, then cools down rapidly after the initial explosion. The cooling down doesn't mean there is no more heat, but rather there will still be remnant heat, but not as hot as the initial explosion. In big bang cosmology, this cosmic microwave background radiation is the remnant heat. Astronomers detected this remnant heat by the COBE probe or Cosmic Background Explorer in 1992. They believe this is what we would expect to find if the hot big bang model is true. Which they claim provided a startling confirmation of the hot big bang model. Some even suggested this as the greatest discovery of all time, while others said that this was like looking at God, at least for those who believed that God used the big bang to create the universe.

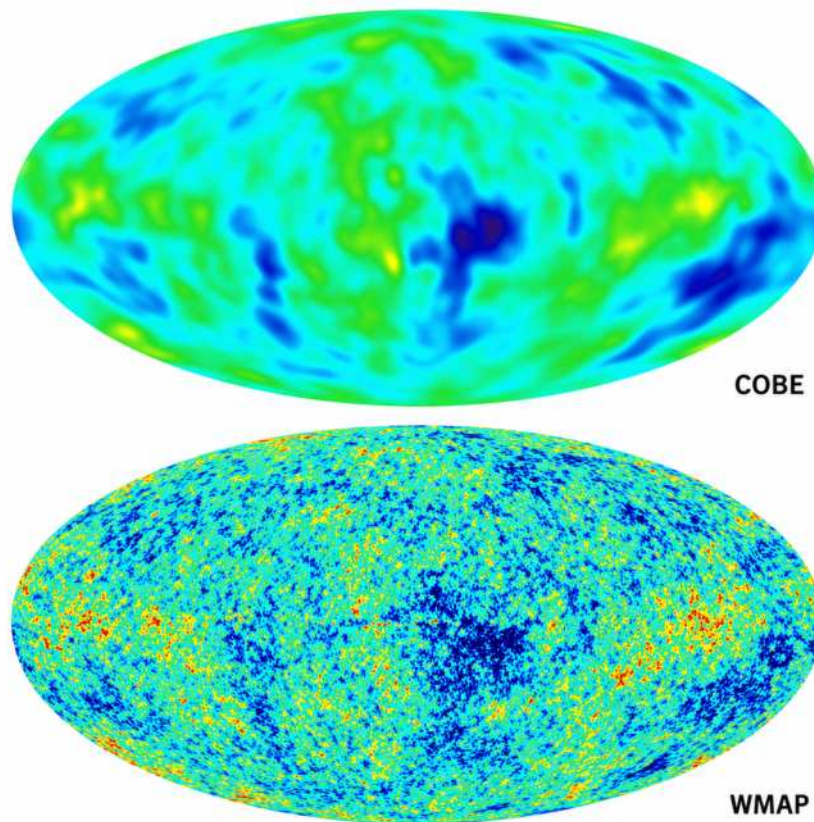


FIGURE 1: Cosmic Microwave Background Map or CMB from early probes - COBE(1992) and WMAP(2003)

2. Further and Deeper Analysis of Analysis of the Radiation

Astronomers were able to construct a map based on this leftover heat. Because the COBE probe and the next probe, the WMAP probe scanned the universe three dimensional, meaning in all directions, it would be harder to look at it that way from our perspective here on earth. So they turned the 3D map into two dimensional or 2D, which is a flat map of the radiation detected all over the universe. Now, astronomers have a special technique on how to detect patterns on this map. It's called Spherical Harmonics. This technique helps astronomers study the geometry and composition of the universe, more specifically the early universe if it's big bang cosmology. In short and easy to understand, Spherical Harmonics, as its applied to the initial CMB map, projects those individual pixels on the map towards a spherical domain. Thereby producing a new map comprising of random shapes.

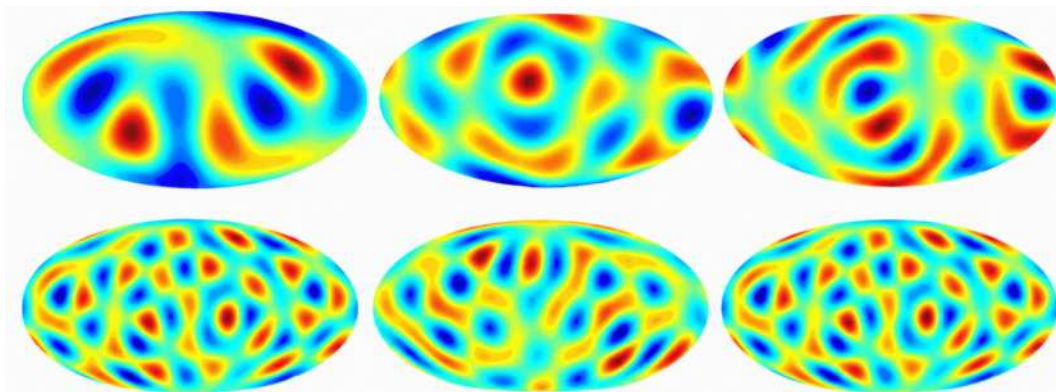


FIGURE 2: CMB maps (Spherical Harmonics Application) Produces random results.

3. Unexpected and Shocking Results

So when our computers finished creating the new map utilizing Spherical Harmonics, they expected to produce random shapes like I said on number two above. But instead of finding random shapes or non significant patterns, they found something amazing instead. They found exactly the opposite of what I just said. They found significant patterns and only one special shape. I'll start with the shape. Several cosmic scale oblong or elongated shapes were discovered, spanning the entire universe. Organized on the cmb map. You wouldn't expect this level of organization if the universe were random or came by accident. Now for the pattern, those oblongs or elongated shapes are also colored red(hot), and blue(cold). They are non-random, forming an A-B-A-B-A-B pattern across the sky, or across the universe. Again you wouldn't expect this if the universe came from an explosion or random unguided expansion, because explosions don't produce significant patterns like these. Even if we were to return the 2D map into 3D, the patterns still exist, and even better in which I'll explain why in a while. Check out the image of what I'm referring to below.

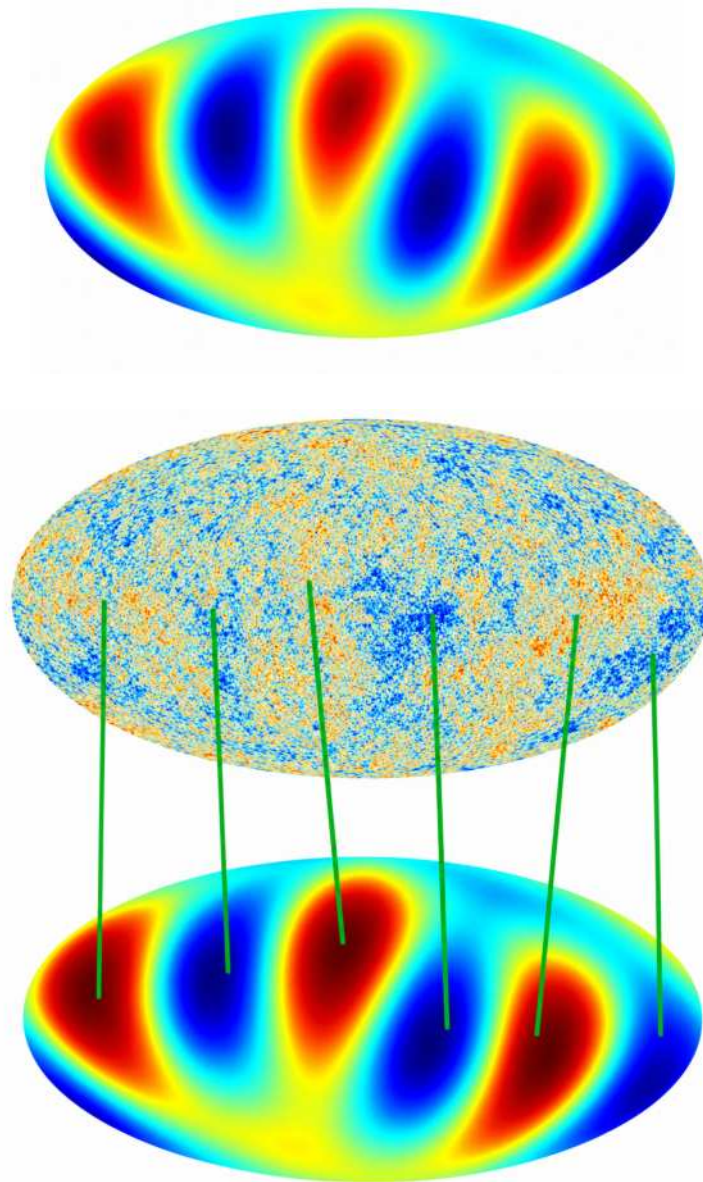


FIGURE 3: Look closely on how Spherical Harmonics works. The pixels from the CMB map matches with the Spherical Harmonics result below.

4. The Cosmic 'Axis of Evil' - The Ecliptic

Before we continue and to make you understand better, the earth is at the precise center of the map because it's from our planet's point of view where our probes scanned the entire sky. Meaning the probes were only within the solar system or around the earth when the scanning took place. Now, if you look at the cmb map with Spherical Harmonics, you will notice those red and blue spots, red then alternate blue, then red again, then blue again, those A-B-A-B-A-B patterns in which I wrote above. These patterns from the left side of the map to right, those oblongs and elongated shapes are going downwards from left to right a bit. They are not perfectly going straight on the map. They are slightly slanted. Yet they still form a straight line from the left corner of the map to the right. From one edge of the universe to the other. This straight line is just beginning to show you that something special is about to be revealed. Now, there is another line most worthy of noting. At the precise middle of the map, imagine a vertical line cutting through the middle of those oblongs or elongated shapes. That's the ecliptic plane of the earth. Notice we are aligned with the entire universe by the clearly shown patterns of those red and blue spots surrounding our ecliptic. You can only see those patterns clearly if we're at the center of it all. Since I said that the earth is at the center of the map, the vertical line which I said above which also carries the red and blue spots intersect with our orbit around the sun, the ecliptic plane. And don't forget that we are talking about the whole universe here. Why is the entire universe aligned with our little planet? It's like the earth was the basis for constructing this universe of ours. It's like using a ruler, aligning it with our planet's ecliptic plane, then based on the ruler's angle this universe is oriented or made. This is the basis on why there is a special direction in space, a direction based upon us, our little planet. A special direction which spans the entire universe. This also means that our little planet is located in a special place in the universe, at its center. What are the odds?

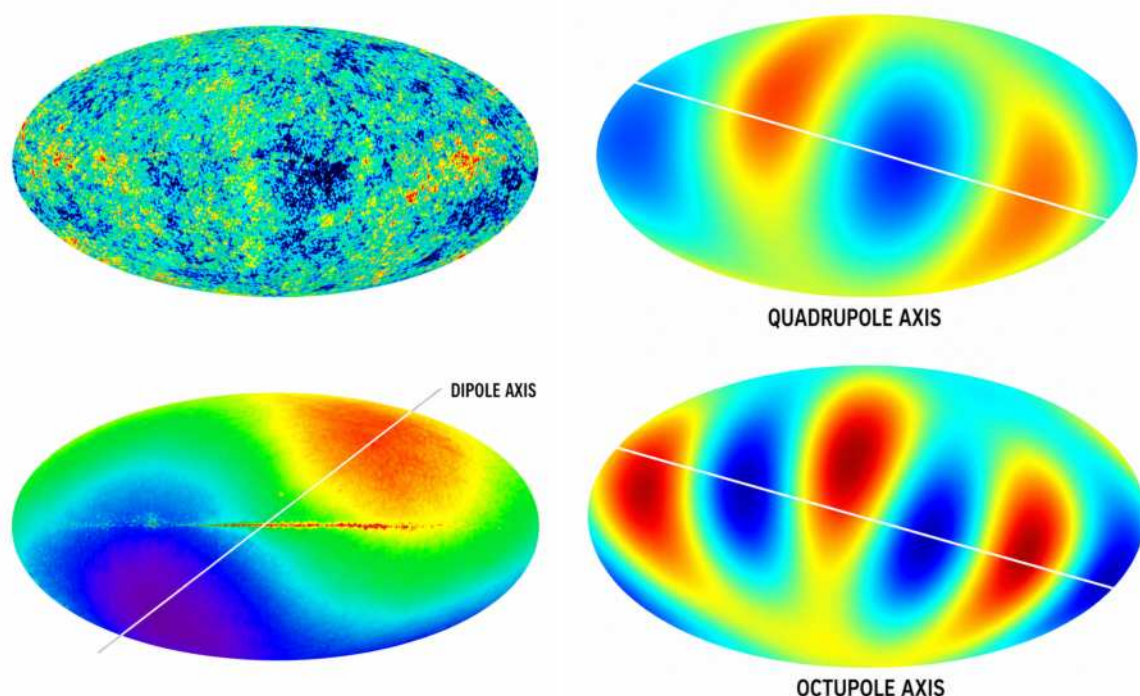


FIGURE 4: Breakdown or configuration adjustments to the map produces several results - dipole, quadrupole and octupole. In short, different angles. Notice pattern of axis found on all configurations.

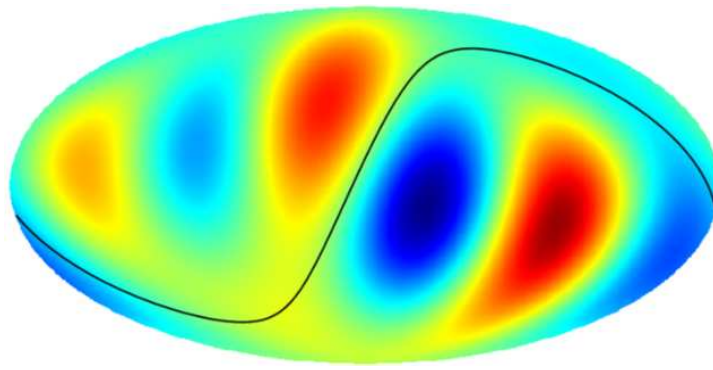


FIGURE 5: The earth's ecliptic plane (black curved line). This image is 2D but it projects the axis like it's 3D. That's why the line is curved.

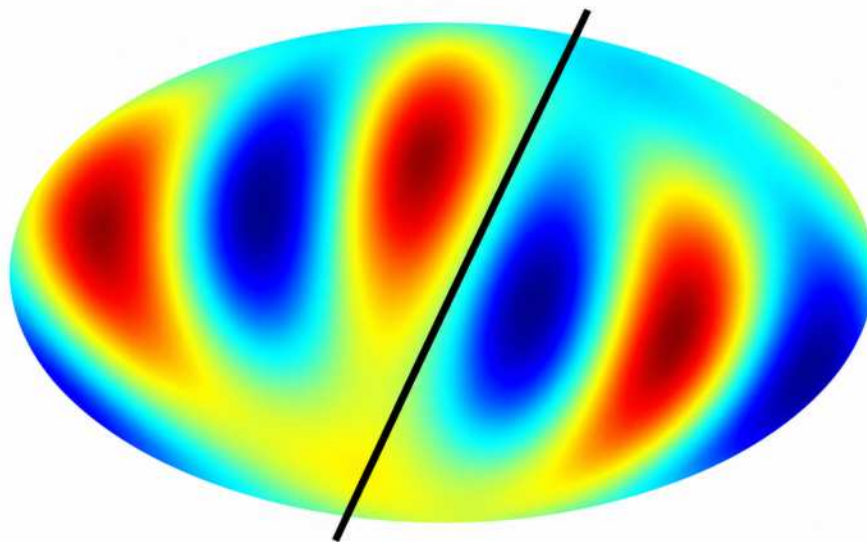
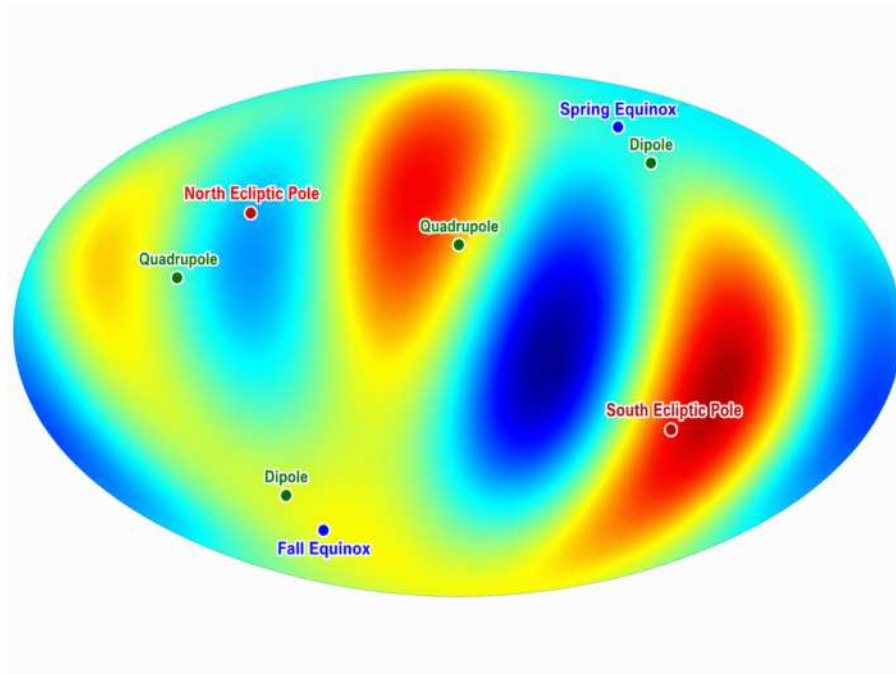


FIGURE 6: The clearly shown black line cutting through the middle of the map is our planet's ecliptic plane. Notice clear patterns around us in all directions.

5. The Cosmic 'Axis of Evil' - The Equatorial

There is actually another alignment suggested by cosmologists. That is our planet's equatorial plane aligning with the universe. This alignment isn't perfect. It's close, but not as good as the ecliptic. So I'll not get deeper into this.

6. The Cosmic 'Axis of Evil' - A Three Dimensional Study and the Theoretical North and South Pole

Remember I said above, at number 2, that the two dimensional cmb map was actually derived from three dimensional? Since the cmb map was a scanned result from all parts of the sky, in all directions of space, we can now create a theoretical 3D map of the universe, but only based on the results from Spherical Harmonics. Meaning the red and blue spots, their shape and patterns turned into a 3D sphere where the earth is not only inside the sphere but also at the middle of it, because when the probes scanned the entire sky, it scanned in all directions like I said so it would be accurate to make a 3D sphere. So since the earth is inside and at the center of this sphere, it is surrounded by pattern after pattern after pattern of red and blue spots. You wouldn't see these patterns precisely if you put the earth somewhere not at the precise middle of that sphere. So you can find the ecliptic plane of the earth at the middle of those patterns, therefore the axis is revealed. Theoretically, the Ecliptic axis won't only be the special evidence here, but everything becomes even more fascinating. If you again look at the spherical 3D version of the map, where we are at the center of it inside of the sphere, from our planet's point of view, you will notice the red(hot) and blue(cold) spots aligning once again with our planet in literally all directions. For example, you will see the red and blue spots forming a color pattern opposite to one another from one side of the sphere to the other side and so on... This means that the universe has a theoretical North and South Pole. If you look at the top of the sphere and correlate it with the red and blue spots around it, then you will realize a North and South Pole exists theoretically. Even while looking from the top view of the sphere looking downwards, patterns of colored red and blue exists. These could also mean a theoretical Western and Eastern Hemisphere existing in the universe. Far from the big bang assumptions of a random universe without a center, special direction, and design.

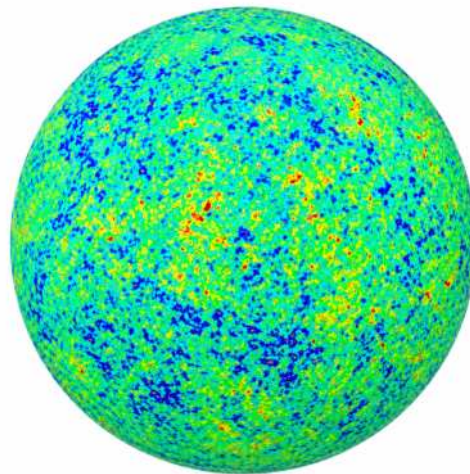


FIGURE 7: CMB map in 3D

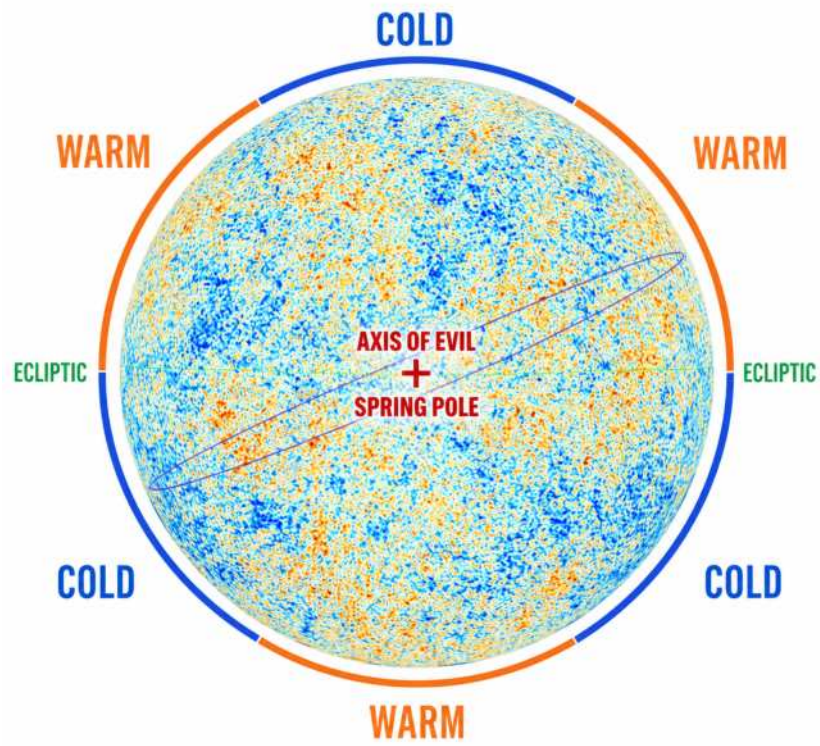


FIGURE 8: Noticeable patterns around our planet.

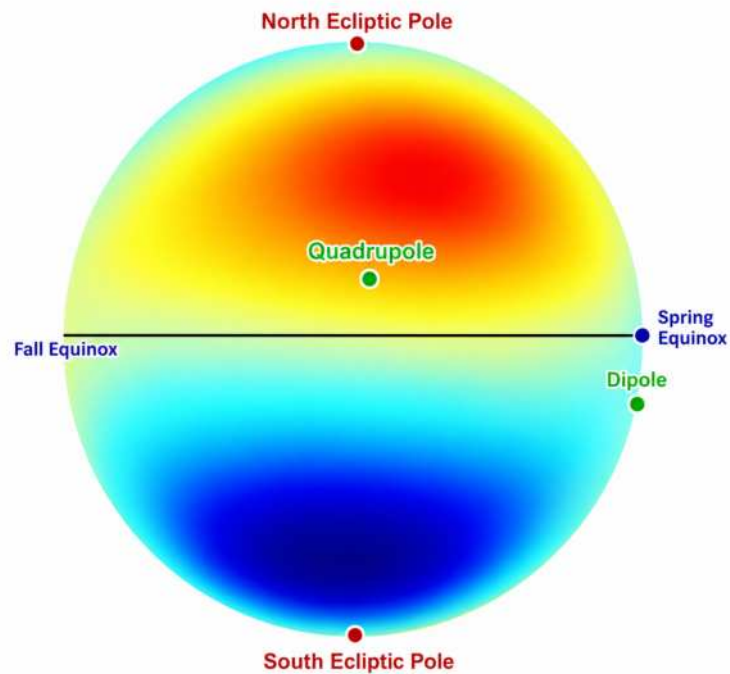


FIGURE 9: CMB map in 3D. Black line is our planet's ecliptic plane. See the patterns above(red) and below(blue) and how they are lined up with our ecliptic plane? Fascinating.

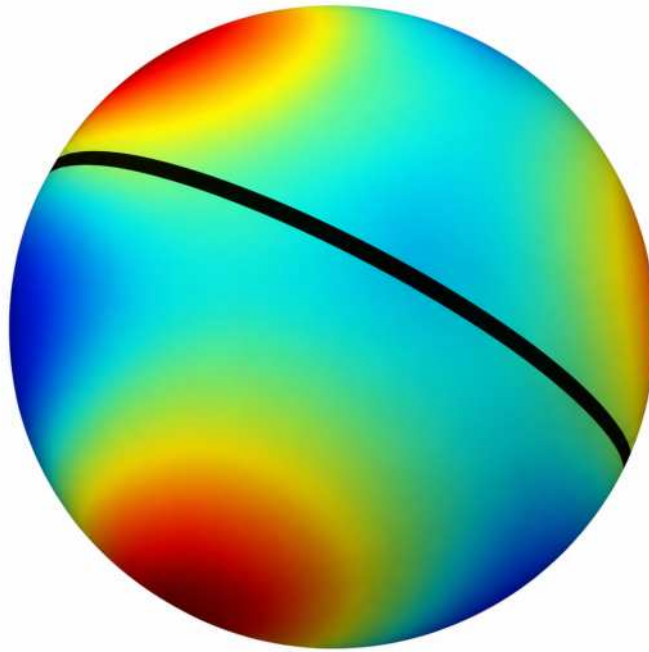


FIGURE 10: CMB map in 3D, another angle. As usual black line is the earth's ecliptic. Notice the North Pole in blue and the South Pole in red? Extraordinary.

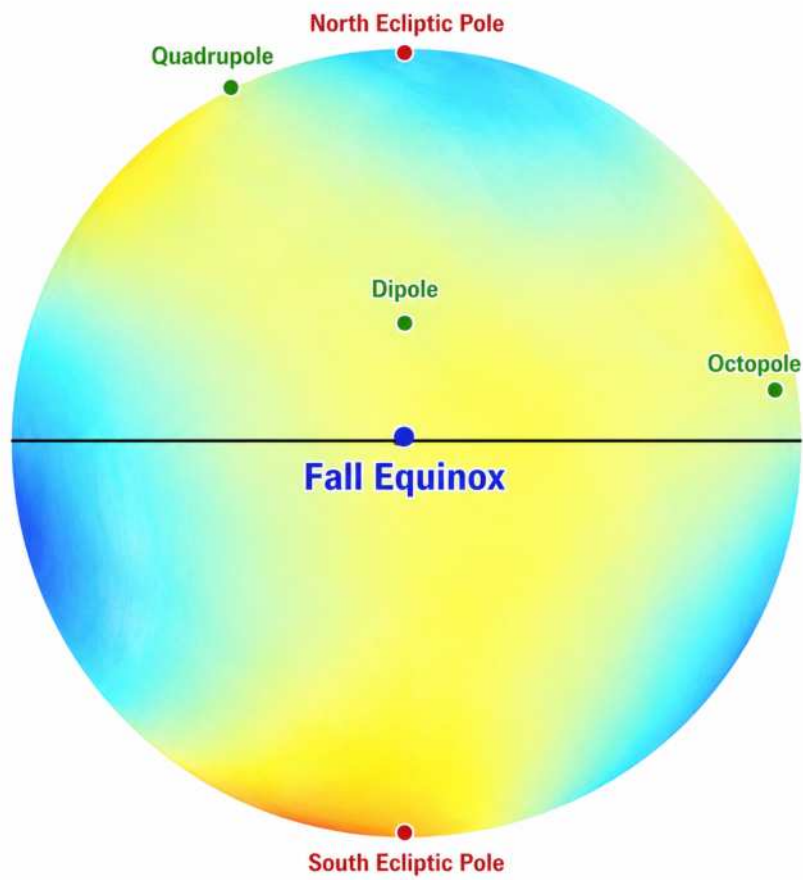


FIGURE 11: CMB map in 3D, a different angle. Notice the sky blue pattern? Also the distribution pattern of the yellow?

7. Cosmologists Scramble

This evidence is totally unexpected. Surprising and shocking to many. That's because everybody thought that the earth centered universe had been debunked long ago. Famous physicist Lawrence Krauss admitted: "The new results are either telling us that all of science is wrong and we're the center of the universe, or maybe the data is simply incorrect, or maybe it's telling us there's something weird about the microwave background results and that maybe, maybe there's something wrong with our theories on the larger scales." He later added: "Is this Copernicus coming back to haunt us? That's crazy. We're looking out at the whole universe. There's no way there should be a correlation of structure with our motion of the earth around the sun... That would say we are truly the center of the universe" That's from a 2006 Edge interview, discussing WMAP satellite data.

8. The Cosmic 'Axis of Evil' - Cannot Be Denied

Since cosmologists scrambled, they, for many years, tried very hard to try and explain away the evidence, but failed. The WMAP (Wilkinson Microwave Anisotropy Probe) was the first to detect the axis in 2005. Since cosmologists cannot believe it, they developed alternative explanations like contamination, instrument errors, statistical anomaly and more. But all these 'rescuing devices' were debunked when the more advanced PLANCK probe confirmed the axis by removing possible contaminations and because the probe was so sophisticated, they had to rule out instrument error.

So to them this remains a mystery. Hoping that future discoveries might solve their problem. To add, some young earth creationists like Dr. Danny Faulkner of Answers in Genesis seem not to embrace the axis fully. He basically claimed that since the axis is too good to be true, then the cmb results must have come from localized radiation, or from our own solar system only, not cosmic in origin. But its only an assumption. The probes already confirmed the axis.

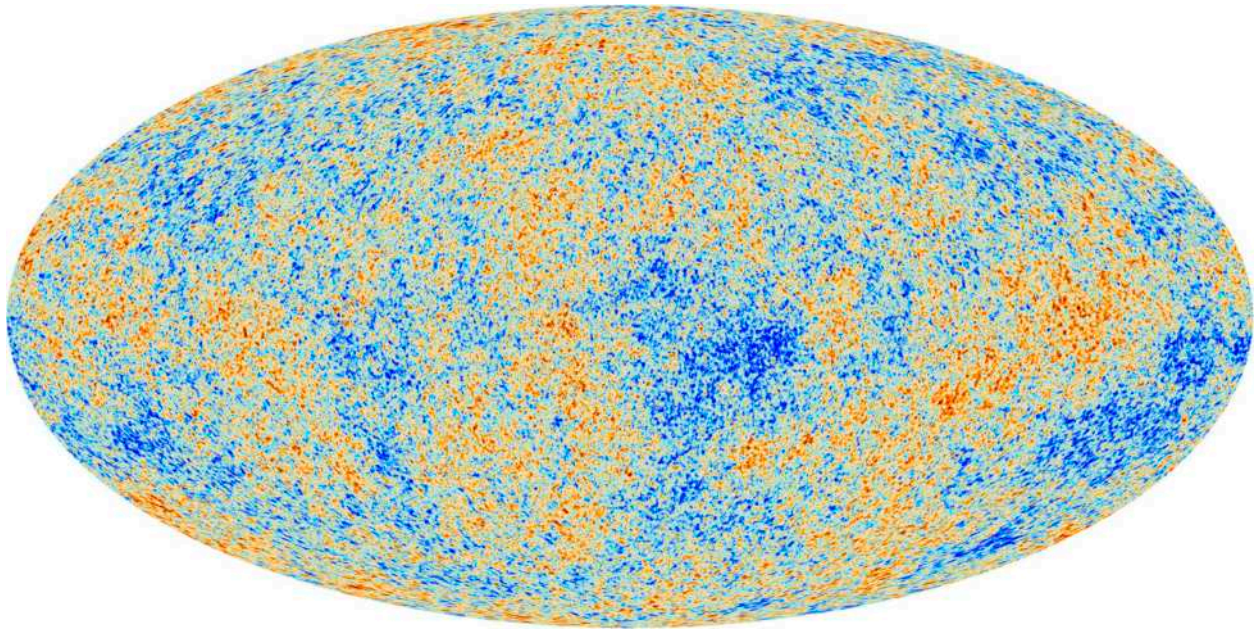
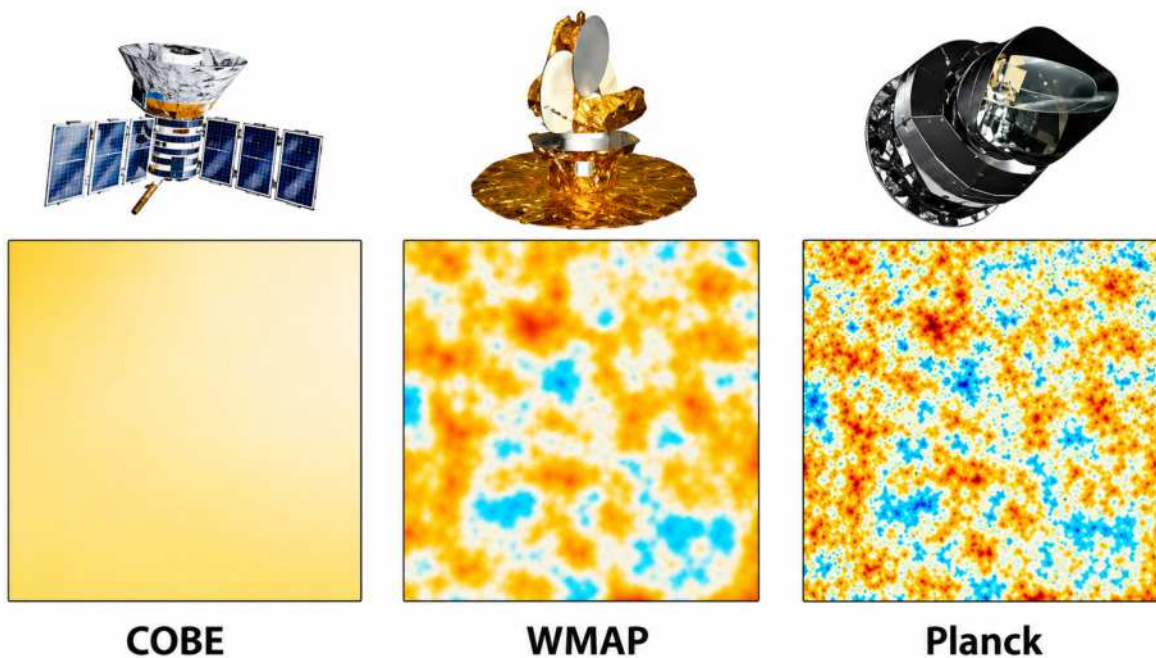


FIGURE 13: CMB from the PLANCK probe. As you can see, it's more detailed.



9. Why call it the 'Axis of Evil'

The axis was named by João Magueijo and his colleague Kate Land, both physicists. They and cosmologists call the axis 'evil' because for them, its so evil and powerful that it alone has the potential to debunk not only the big bang, but also the Copernican Principle and the Heliocentric Model.
